This form includes leadership information for all church mission leaders, Baptist Men/Men's Ministry groups, adult coed missions, youth and children coed, Royal Ambassador chapters, and Challenger groups. **To be on this mailing list for next year, every church needs to complete a new registration form even if the leaders remain the same.**

Baptists on Mission requests that you please complete your leadership information online at the SBC Workspace website: <http://nc.sbcworkspace.com> and email lharrington@ncbaptist.org to let Lynn know it has been done **OR** complete the enclosed form and return to the NCBM office no later than November 1, 2020. **IMPORTANT: Remember to delete leadership who are no longer serving in any position on that form.** When using the SBC Workspace website, you will need to obtain the user name and password. ► IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. If your church **does not have** a missions program of any kind, please indicate by checking the box at the top of the form and return for our records.
2. In addition, if your church does not have a missions program, it would be helpful if you would please list someone in your church who would be willing to serve as a missions contact and receive mail from our office on mission projects. You will find a place for this name under the first category on the page, **"Church Missions Contact Person."**
3. If you do have a Men's/Challengers'/Royal Ambassadors' program or a **coed** missions program (men/women or boys/girls), please complete the mailing list with the leadership for 2020-2021. Print or type if possible. These names should be the leadership for the upcoming new church year.
4. In order for us to better communicate with your church missions' leadership, please be sure to include **email addresses** if at all possible. We will send information that is relevant only to our area of work.

Your role is so important - the only way mission leaders will receive the proper information is for you to complete this form. So much is **depending on your taking time to help us** with this important task. Please secure the names, mailing addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses of those who will be serving as mission leaders for the 2020-2021 year. **If updates on SBC Workspace are made by someone from your church, please DELETE NAMES WHO ARE NO LONGER SERVING in addition to adding the new ones.**
